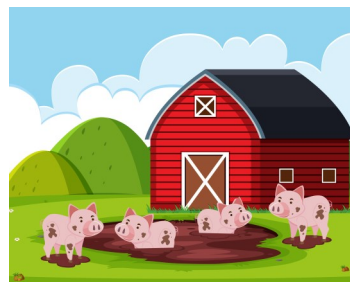
### **Easter Egg Hunt**
